# THE TIME IS NOW...

Since opening in 2004, Janesville Performing Arts Center has welcomed 292,915 patrons to 1,475 events becoming an important anchor in our downtown.

JPAC provides a professional home venue for local groups and serves as a center for the community to become involved in the arts through performances, lectures, gallery exhibits, public rentals, and educational activities. JPAC was constructed for approximately \$4 million 15 years ago and receives no public funding. As the vision for Downtown Janesville takes shape, attention turns to funding two essential projects to ensure that JPAC, an ARISE Now partner, is able to grow and attract patrons to downtown:

**Technology Upgrades** • The lighting and sound equipment have not been updated since 2003 ... Imagine your cell phone 15 years ago! JPAC plans to install more professional, cost-efficient LED lighting and sound equipment that will make it comparable to premier venues in Madison and Milwaukee. A load-in door and an updated front entryway will allow JPAC to bring in acts with larger props and sets and provide a more positive resident group experience.

**Education Outreach Center** • To accommodate the tremendous growth over the last several years, the Education and Outreach Center will move into the old pool area that is adjacent to the JPAC main lobby. By repurposing this unused space, the new center will have dedicated area for rehearsal and classes, providing a safe and professional space to inspire all ages to explore and develop art. Currently, classes are held in the Gallery or in the lobby of JPAC.

The goal is to raise \$500,000 in total for these projects. Naming rights are available.
